You should not...

- Be confused with attachments.
- Be confused with detachments.

You should understand...

- Task organisation details the allocation and command status of formations or units within a force.
- Task organisation begins after **Couse of Action analysis**, when command assigns tasks to sub units.

Also you should understand...

When command assigns tasks to sub unit, need to determine whether sub units have sufficient combat power necessary.

■ Task org provides basis for **organisation available forces** to best accomplishment of the mission.



COMPILING OF GRAPHICAL TASK ORGANISATION



CONVENTIONS

- The formation or unit compiling the task organisation is reffered to as the originator.
- Aim is to produce a clear, logical and unambiguous picture of the group of the various formations/units, including their respective status of command for an operation.
- > Separate task organisation should be needed for **each and every Cause** of Action.
- Separate task organisation may be needed for each phase of operations if **significant regrouping** take place.




ACCOUNTING

- Double entry book keeping is adopted.
- There are some exceptions to this and they are:
 - Services need not to be shown as formation troops unless there is a significant change to group or command status.
 - If a sub-unit is attach to a formation and group in its entirely to a subordinate formation/unit, it needs not to be shown under the higher formation Headquaters, either as a credit or a debit.





FORMAT

- Task organisation is prepared in columns.
- Each column is headed by the symbol of the formation/unit immediately subordinate to the originating formation. Troops allocation for special task should be under the 'Special Task' column.
- > Troops organic to the originator are listed under separate column.
- Blank column under the heading of notes for further re-grouping.





STATUS OF COMMAND

- UC Under command.
- UCM Under command for movement.
- UCADMIN Under command for admin.
- > UCDM Under command for daily maintenance.
- INSPUCM In support under command for movement.

PRECEDENCE

- Armour.
- Infantry.
- Mechanised Infantry.
- > Artillery.
- Engineers.
- Communication.
- Engineer Services.
- Supply and Transport.
- Medical.
- Ordnance.

Provost

Electrical and Mechanical Engineers.

- In order of unit precedence within each arm.
- Within each arm or services in order of size and then, if the size is same in numerical order.



BATTLE GROUP FIELD INDICATOR

- If the parent unit column provided the Headquarters for a Battle Group, it is **not necessary to list all organic sub-units** which are to remain with it.
- Any detachment from a unit are then shown in the main column with a minus sign if appropriate.
- > Any detachment from that unit are then shown as debit at the bottom of the column.
- The symbol at the **top of the column** should be **capped indicating** that it **forms the Headquarters of an arms group**.



DETACHMENTS


- When a formation is **detached from its parent formation**, it is assumed that **only the Headquarters and its own Infantry and armour units go with it**.
- If artillery, engineer or other units move with brigade, they must be shown as detachments from divisional troops unless they are organic.
- Similarly, if a company detaches from a battalion with an allocation of support weapons, the detached elements must be shown in the debit column.




HALF BARS

- Half bars are used in the 'Special Task' column where there is more than one special task annotated in a single column.
- Follow the rules of para heading in **non-operational Staff Duties**; continue down to the **next special task which is ident with full bar**.









ARTILLERY



COMMAND STATUS

- Artillery regiment are usually affiliated not only with brigade, but also, with divisions and higher formations.
- Their command status will be decided by artillery command.
- Followings are the common status:
 - Under Command.
 - Under Command for Move.
 - Under Command for Admin.
 - Under Command for Daily Maintenance.



ALLOTMENT

- The allotment refers to the firepower of artillery unit.
- An artillery unit Under Command to one formation may be in a position to provide fire support to another formation and as such its fire power may be allotted without moving the guns.
- > Allotment of artillery effort can take any of the following forms:
 - In direct support (IN DS).
 - In support (IN SP).
 - At priority call (AT PRI CALL).


